

## SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

**Service Opportunities** are designed for high school (age 16+) and college students to meet state community service requirements for the Tennessee Promise Scholarship and/or to earn service-learning credits for course, financial aid, work ethic, or graduation obligations required by similar initiatives. The following volunteer opportunities require a minimum of 1-hour to a maximum of 8-hour service commitment by the participant that meets specific state, local, or school deadlines.



Annual event in **April** to help students earn up to eight (8) hours of community service while experiencing the functions of a dynamic social enterprise whose **Mission** is to provide employment services to those in need. Pre-registration is required for limited volunteer enrollments. Event information and pre-registration instructions are published by March each year.



Annual event in **November** to help students earn up to eight (8) hours of community service while experiencing recycling and sustainability programs that support Goodwill's **Core Value #11: Recycle, Reduce, Reuse & Repurpose**. Pre-registration is required for limited volunteer enrollments. Event information and pre-registration instructions are published by October each year.
